









The average unemployment rate in 2017 is 2.5% which is lower than the World Average Unemployment Rate









Number of new and current students in higher education institutes base on major, nationality and gender 2017 - 2018





Inflation rate in consumer prices by major expenditure groups 2017



The average inflation rate in the UAE is less than the world rate in 2017






Total real GDP growth in the UAE during the last ten years 2007 - 2017 is 33.8% (Million AED)





Non-Oil real GDP growth in UAE during the last ten years 2007- 2017 is 42.1% (Million AED)

Non-oil trade value by major trading partners in billion dirhams, 2017








